



Shortline Ramp Festival Cook-off Rules

- Participation in this event is FREE. However, if a participant plans to sell anything other than samples, they must pay the \$20 vendor fee and fill out that form.
- Participants may enter additional items for the cook-off by paying an additional registration \$5 fee per item
- In order to have their name listed on the ballot, participants must preregister no later than April 6th, 2022
- Same day registration will be available, but will be listed only with a number on the ballot.
- Participants will be assigned a booth number for judging
- Participants are responsible for all of their own supplies & food
- Sample servings of judged item must be sold for \$.50 for People's Choice Award - participant can determine their own portion size
- Participants keep all proceeds from sales
- Voting will be held at a centralized location
- People's choice award will be chosen in the business category, individual category and non-profit category

All food must be prepared in a kitchen that has been approved by the health department, by a cook who has a valid food handler's card.

Trophies will be awarded in each category at 3 PM.

All cooking/heating should be done on gas or charcoal grills, or slow cooker. Precautions must be made to prevent any fire or injury threat.
